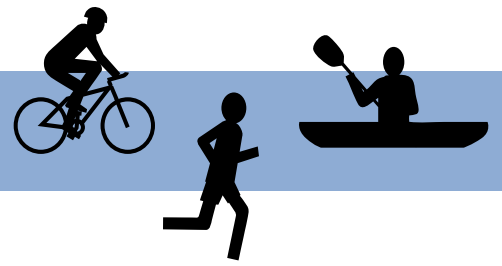

SAMPLE COURSES



DENVER OYSTER: PASSPORT 1 – UNDER THE SEA

Destination – Denver Aquarium. On foot, make your way to Denver Aquarium. Locate the back entrance (on south side of the building) and make your way up the stairs to the Reservoir exhibit where a team member will rinse off, put on a wet suit, mask and free dive. Dive down and find a card that will be placed at different depths (no more then 10 feet deep). Return to the surface and give the card to the Oyster volunteer to receive your punch mark. Wet suits and masks are provided. Only one team member may complete this passport.



SAN FRANCISCO OYSTER: PASSPORT 2 – BRIDGE OVER TROUBLED WATER

Destination – Golden Gate Bridge. From Presidio Golf Course, make your way on foot to the Golden Gate Bridge. Locate the sign pictured below and snap a shot in front of it with all teammates present. Upon completion, make your way back to the transition area to receive your punch mark and next passport.



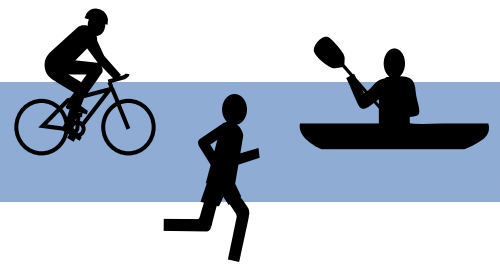
SEATTLE OYSTER: PASSPORT 3 – FLYING FISH

Destination – Whole Foods. All three teammates run to Whole Foods on Westlake. Enter the building and go to the patio area where two team members will re-create the famous Flying Fish scene of Pike Place Market. Throw your flying fish from the patio to the street where your second team member must catch it. If you drop the fish, go to the end of the line and do the task again until completed correctly. Once you catch the flying fish, have your passport punched. Also, while here, you must go inside Whole Foods and buy 3 locally grown items and bring back to transition area to complete passport (food will be donated to a local shelter or soup kitchen).

AUSTIN OYSTER: PASSPORT 4 – BARTON'S BELT IS MADE OF ROPE

Destination – Barton Creek Green Belt/Gus Fruh Wall. On bike, head to Barton Creek Green Belt and the Gus Fruh access. Park your bike at the entrance with the Oyster representative and by foot locate the Gus Fruh climbing wall. Designate one teammate to harness up and make their way to the top and ring the cow bell to receive the punch mark. Although only one team member is climbing, all members must be present. Return to RunTex after the task is completed.



NASHVILLE OYSTER: PASSPORT 5 – REMEMBER THE TITANS

Destination – LP (Titan) Stadium. On foot, head to LP field and locate Gate 7 and Section 127. Locate the volunteer at the bottom of the section and prepare to sit in every seat in that section. All 3 team members must sit in each seat until you reach the top of the section where the volunteer will punch your passport. Upon completion, make your way back to the transition area for your next passport.



PORTLAND OYSTER: PASSPORT 6 – EBONY & IVORY

Destination – Portland's Rose Garden. On bike, head to Portland's Rose Garden and locate the Pearl rose and the blackest rose (we are looking for a specific rose - see photo hint below) in the gardens and get a picture with one of your team members in front of their designated signs (see below for example). Do NOT pick the roses! Once complete, make your way back to the transition area with your photos to receive your punch mark and next passport.
